

To Delete and Expire Leads:

1. You can delete the lead in Available Leads as long as they have not been assigned. I believe most yours were not assigned. Edit each lead, scroll to bottom of screen and delete. You may be asked "Are you Sure", click Delete.
2. You can expire them by editing the lead and adding 0 or 1 to the Expire Day Exclusive and Expire Day Non Exclusive fields.

Make sure you click Save.

You need to edit each lead to do the above 2 steps.

NOTE: Adding 0 moves the lead immediately to expired leads; adding 1 will move it to expired lead the next day. You can also put in a number prior to the date it was entered.

Enter 0 in the Expire Day Exclusive field and Expire Day Non Exclusive field. This expires the lead immediately.

OR

Enter 1 in the same fields to expire the lead the next day.

To Change an Expire Lead back to an Available Lead:

1. You can also change an expired lead back to available lead if you decide to assign it to a number higher than For example, if the lead was created into the Expire Day Exclusive fields. This will put the leads where it can be

For example if lead was created on 1/22/07, enter 35 in Expire Day Exclusive and Expire Day Non Exclusive Filed to return Expired Lead back to Available Leads.

to someone by change the days the creation date. on 1/22/07. Enter 35 and Expire Day Non Exclusive lead back into the Available assigned to an affiliate.

Make sure you click Save.

You need to edit each Expired Lead to make to it back to Available Leads. You can get the creation date from the list of your expired leads.
